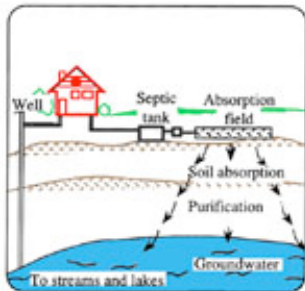

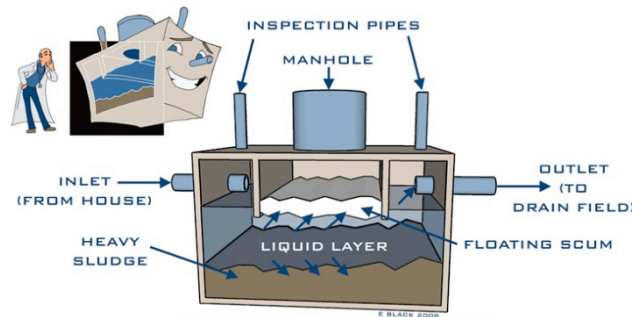

### Lodging

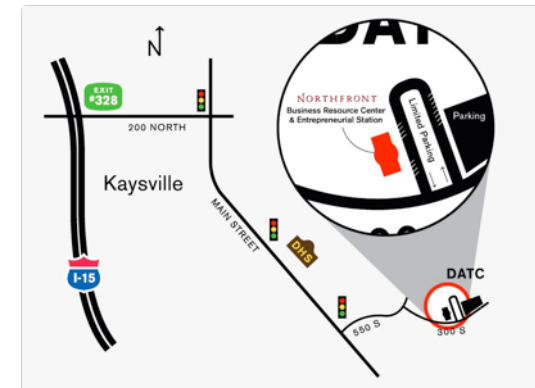
