

**NOTICE OF DATA REQUEST FOR CLEAN WATER ACT  
SECTION 305(b) STATE WATER QUALITY ASSESSMENT  
INTEGRATED REPORT 2008**

The Division of Water Quality (DWQ) of the Utah Department of Environmental Quality will be assessing the waters of the State (streams and lakes) to determine their support of their designated beneficial uses for the 2008 Integrated Report. The Integrated Report includes the 305(b) assessment report and the 303(d) list of impaired waters. Beneficial uses include potential source of drinking water, primary and secondary contact recreation, aquatic life, and agriculture.

The Division of Water Quality monitoring teams have collected data over several years to be used in evaluating stream and lake water quality. To assist the DWQ in making assessments, we are letting individuals or organizations know through this public notice that if they would like to submit data to be used in making assessments, they should contact Tom Toole at 801-538-6859 or e-mail him at [ttoole@utah.gov](mailto:ttoole@utah.gov) for information on what the Division considers credible data and formats for the submission of such data. To be assured that the data being submitted will be considered for the 2008 305(b) Integrated Report and 303(d) list, it should be submitted to the Division by March 15, 2007.

To be consistent with the DWQ assessment schedule, only data collected prior to January 1, 2007 should be submitted.
